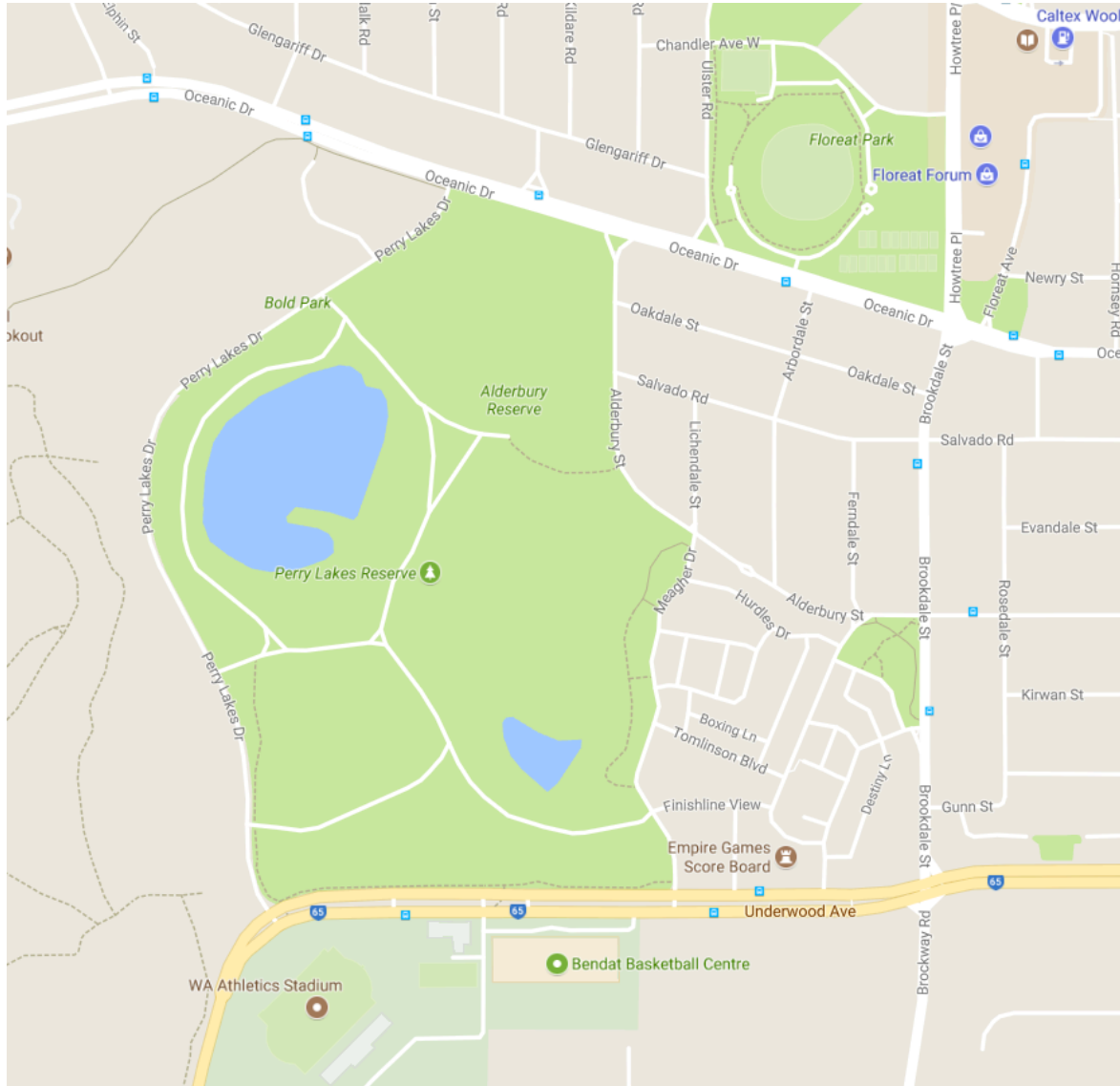


AEON | Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE

Where is the show?

The performance will be held in the vicinity of [Perry Lakes Reserve](#), Floreat. You will be sent the starting location by text message on the evening prior to the performance.



I have an international phone number, can I still receive my text message?

No, unfortunately we can only accept Australian mobiles (with the prefix +61 or 04). We recommend providing an Australian mobile, or contacting PICA on 9228 6300 to arrange to receive the start location over the phone or by email.

It's 6pm the day before the show and I haven't received my starting location. What should I do?

Don't worry! Just call PICA on 9228 6300 and we will send you the location.

I can't book tickets online for the show today?

Online bookings close the day before the performance. Booking enquiries on the day of the show should be made directly to PICA's Reception on 9228 6300.

I'm sensitive to loud noise. Can I attend this production?

There is a section of loud sound at the end of the performance. Ear plugs are provided but please let PICA know before the performance to discuss your needs.

Is the work suitable for children?

Aeon is recommended for ages 15 years and over. It is unsuitable for babies and small children given the physical nature of the work and the loud sound.

I have additional mobility requirements (wheelchair). Can I attend this production?

Yes! Please get in contact with PICA to let them know your needs so we can ensure the best experience for you.

Can I bring my dog?

No, given the nature of the work, it is not suitable to bring pets.

What should I wear?

You'll be walking outdoors for roughly an hour. We recommend comfy shoes, clothing you can move in, a hat and sunscreen for hot weather.

WHAT TO DO ON THE DAY

How do I get there?

By bus, take the 81 or 82 Bus from Perth City Bus Port. Routes starting from Perth Busport are approx. 20 minutes (without traffic) to Stop # 12747 (Oceanic Dr after Alderbury St).

By car, the reserve is a 15 minute drive (without traffic) from the CBD area and accessible off Oceanic Drive, Floreat. Carparks are located along Perry Lakes Drive and near the start location.

It's raining. What do I do?

The show will go ahead, but bring some wet weather gear. If it gets really stormy, we will need to cancel the performance. We'll call you if this happens.

It's super hot. What do I do?

Bring sunscreen, a hat and a water bottle. The show involves slow walking for an hour and you can move at your own pace.

How much time should I plan to find the start location once I've arrived at the reserve?

We recommend allowing for 15 minutes to walk comfortably to your start location.

I'm running late on the day, stuck in traffic or can't find my start location?

Call the number included in your text message and await instructions.

Does the show end back at the start location?

No. The show will finish in the vicinity of the Scout Hall in Alderbury Reserve, located [here](#)

I parked further than I expected and am having trouble finding my car?

Speak to PICA's FOH team on site after the show; we will help you find your way back.

I brought a bag and I don't want to carry it around?

We recommend not bringing bulky items or bags – please only bring anything you're comfortable carrying. Speak with PICA's FOH team on arrival for any issues.

Where are the nearest public toilets?

There are public toilets located throughout the grounds, including next to the Hockey Club Hall in [Alderbury Reserve](#) and the [Perry Lakes Reserve Playground](#)

Do I need to bring my own water?

You're welcome to but there are drinking fountains in the grounds and light refreshments will be served after the show.

I feel unwell or wish to leave the performance

There will be a safety briefing prior to the show with further instructions.
