

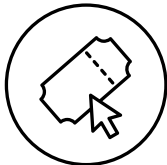
PICA Performance Space COVID-19 Safety Measures

PICA has a COVID-19 Safety Plan in place, which oversees our daily operations and has allowed us to resume in-house programming, including live performance.

The health and wellbeing of our artists, audiences and staff is paramount.



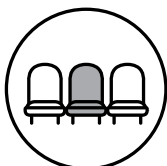
We ask all patrons to join PICA in being COVID safe and aware. Please stay home if you are displaying cold/flu symptoms.



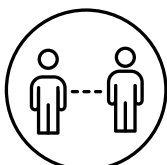
If you are feeling unwell we ask you to stay at home and we will offer you a refund. Refunds will only be provided if you contact us in advance of the event. Refunds are not possible if you changed your mind or are unable to attend for reasons other than illness.



Hand sanitising stations are located throughout all our venues and we encourage good hygiene practices when you visit.



PICA is adhering to WA Government advice around how we ticket our performances. From 24 October 2020, selected venues that predominantly hold seated events are exempt from the 2sqm rule and can operate at 60% capacity for seated performances. PICA is taking a conservative approach to implementing this new measure to provide a positive and safe experience for our audiences – we ask you to continue to observe 1.5m physical distancing where relevant and possible. All other publicly accessible areas of PICA (foyers, galleries) remain subject to capacities set by the 1 person per 2sqm rule.



Please practise physical distancing when queuing in any area of the theatre and foyer. Please observe the signage throughout the venue.
