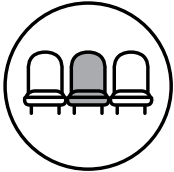


# PICA

PICA has a comprehensive COVID-19 Safety Plan in place, which oversees our daily operations and has allowed us to resume in-house programming, including public events.

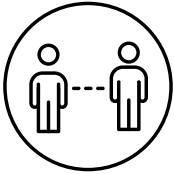
We want our community and audience to feel welcome and safe at PICA.

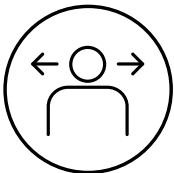
