



**Activity instructions and notes:**

Plan a route to walk. Your task is to pick up items and objects that you come across as you follow a path and thread them onto your lei. These things will probably be a mix of both man-made and natural objects.



Do not use anything larger than a grape, or if it is something large see if you can cut it down into more manageable pieces

Consider how you may attach objects that you cannot pierce with a needle – you may be able to cut or drill a hole into them when you return home. Or tie them onto the lei.

What does your lei tell you about the human relationship to environment around you?  
How have you used the found objects you came across in creative ways?

Imagine you had to welcome a guest to the location of your walk by donning them with your lei. What will it signify?

Hang your lei somewhere important, as the environment is precious!
